Information regarding Admission to Class VI (for 2019)

1. Ramakrishna Mission Vidyapith, Deoghar, Jharkhand, established in 1922 is a branch centre of the Ramakrishna Mission, founded by Swami Vivekananda. Affiliated to the C.B.S.E., New Delhi this is a residential English medium Senior Secondary school for boys from **class VI to class XII**. Boys from all cross sections of society, irrespective of caste, creed, religion and nationality are **admitted at two entry points viz. class VI and class XI only**.
2. **Prospectus etc.:** The Prospectus and Application Forms will be available at the Vidyapith book-sales counter from **1st July, 2018** [time: 9.00 am to 12.00 noon and 3.00 pm to 5.30 pm], @ **Rs. 650/-**. To get by registered post, please pay **Rs. 700/- by Demand Draft** drawn on any bank payable at Deoghar in favour of **Ramakrishna Mission Vidyapith**. Money Orders, Postal Orders and e-transactions are not accepted. For **online form**, please logon to **www.rkmvdeoghar.org**.
3. a) **Application Forms :** Last date of availability : **31st October, 2018**
With late fee: **till 15th November, 2018**.
[Late Fee : Rs. 100/-]
b) The duly filled-in forms may be deposited by hand at the Vidyapith Central Office during the above-mentioned hours (as indicated in the Item 2) or sent by registered post so as **to reach latest by 15th November 2018**. Guardians are requested to submit the duly completed forms at the earliest, in order to facilitate timely processing and the issuance of Admit Cards. Filled in form must reach **within one month** from date of issue (counter or online).
4. **Admit Card:** To be issued by **November 2018**. Any kind of enquiry may be made by **10th December 2018**, either in person or over the phone. Incomplete forms will not be entertained.
5. **General norms** regarding the eligibility for admission:

6. **Requirement of Aadhaar :** Aadhaar Number/Aadhaar Enrollment Number of the candidate is mandatory for submission of Application Form. Candidates shall enter Aadhaar Number, name & date of birth in application form as per the Aadhaar Card.

7. Admission Test:

A) First phase: Sunday, 16th December 2018.

To be held simultaneously at the allotted examination centres in **Asansol, Chapra, Deoghar, Guwahati, Kolkata, Manipur and Ranchi**. The assigned venue and the time of examination will be given in the Admit Card.

Note: A **written test of total 3 hours** duration (including seating, checking etc.) will be conducted in this phase. Candidates will enter the respective examination halls with admit cards and pens as specified in their admit cards. The list of the successful candidates (except those from Guwahati and Manipur centres) from this written test will be released within 15 days approximately.

B) Second & Final phase: The qualified candidates out of the above written test will appear in a viva-voce test (including a short written exam) at the Ramakrishna Mission Vidyapith, Deoghar on a notified date in January, 2019. The list of selected candidates will include students from different regions, caste & religions. The list of finally selected candidates will be notified on the website (www.rkmvdeoghar.org). Enquiry can also be made over phone at 06432-222413, 236854.

8. Medical Test: The medical test etc. of each candidate qualified for the Second & Final phase of Test will be conducted on the day of the Second and Final Test.

9. Syllabus for Preparation: The syllabus for admission test (in respect of class VI) covers topics taught in class V & above, according to CBSE course. Textbooks of NCERT may, therefore, be helpful for the preparation. Questions in Mathematics and Basic Science will examine the students' understanding of the fundamentals at their level. For English and Vernacular — knowledge of basic grammar, vocabulary, spelling, comprehension of given passages, essay writing and expression will be examined. Sample question papers are not provided.

10. Cancellation: Selection is liable to be cancelled if any irregularity is found (including the health report) in the application form. Suppression of facts may lead to the removal of the boy at any time, even after his admission. Anomaly in the date of birth and in the declared height may result in non-selection of the candidate.

11. Instruction to guardians: Parents/Legal guardians are to accompany their wards during the final test. They will be required to produce the original documents. Their wards will be tested mainly for general intelligence, expression and personality in the Second & Final Test. There is no syllabus for it but the questions will be in conformity with their age and standard. Finally selected candidates will be informed by email and website notification within a month following the Admission Test. The new session will start in April 2019.

No accommodation in the Vidyapith campus will be provided during the tests. The Ramakrishna Mission neither conducts nor supports any type of Coaching/ training/ tutorial centre meant for its admission tests anywhere. The Ramakrishna Mission does not have any *other* residential school in Jharkhand & Bihar.
